

PUBLIC SALES ON SCHOOL PROPERTY REGULATION

Door to Door Solicitations

No student may be asked to go door-to-door under school district auspices, without the prior approval of the Superintendent of Schools. Collection and solicitation will be considered for approval in the following situations:

1. There has been a well established tradition of door-to-door soliciting;
2. All net proceeds collected will be used for school purposes;
3. Each person contacted in the home determines the amount they contribute; and
4. The project involves a broad base rather than something of a limited scope.

Fundraising activities sponsored by organizations represented by the President's Council shall be approved only during non-school hours. These activities shall be conducted as to minimize the amount of school time required and to emphasize school spirit.

All activities shall be voluntary and no identifying devices shall be used for students who contribute or participate.

Literature which is sponsored by organizations that are represented by the President's Council may be distributed at the discretion of the Superintendent.
