

## **PUBLIC SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION**

Resident pupils are eligible for transportation between home/childcare location and the District school they legally attend, in accordance with State Education law and Board of Education policies.

K thru 12 Students who wish to utilize an established bus route other than the one they have been assigned (i.e., late bus route, drop off to an alternate residence) must have a written bus pass in their possession before they are allowed to board the alternate bus. Bus passes must be completely filled out and signed by the school principal or his/her designee(s). Bus passes will not be used to provide drop off at a students work location or at a day camp or after school program operated for the purpose of religious education, sports, or recreation.

Students are not entitled to “door to door” transportation. It is the responsibility of the parent, guardian, or daycare provider to insure safe travel of the student(s) to and/or from the bus stop.
