First, I would like to thank you for your attendance at the June 4<sup>th</sup> parent meeting with the Board of Education. Our desire to meet and present the context for the conversation was very important. While we all bring different perspectives to the table and conversations like we had last night can be difficult at times, I think we can all agree that these discussions are important to have. Likewise, we all want Clarksville's students -- and all BC students -- to learn and grow in supportive, nurturing and appropriate educational environments. While this situation is still taking shape, I firmly believe that all of Clarksville's students will be in such an environment next year.

As a result of our meeting the following was presented:

1. The District will be assigning new entrants to the District to Clarksville for the K-1 classes as capacity in other home schools is reached.
2. We will keep an open communication format with parents through email to the superintendent ([mtebbano@bcisd.neric.org](mailto:mtebbano@bcisd.neric.org)). Information and inquiries from parents will be answered in a "frequently asked questions" (FAQ) format on the Clarksville home page.
3. As developments and information are decided regarding the sections at Clarksville we will use the SNN notifier system to inform you that more information has been placed online for your review.
4. The school district will work to create the best workable solution for the situation as is possible with the idea that multi-age class(es) may be necessary.
5. Dorothy McDonald and I will work to coordinate a committee of Clarksville parent reps to coordinate enrichment and supportive activities with other schools in the District.
