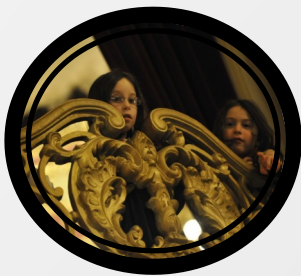
# Sunday Symphonies for Families
